- Building a long term local community water plan

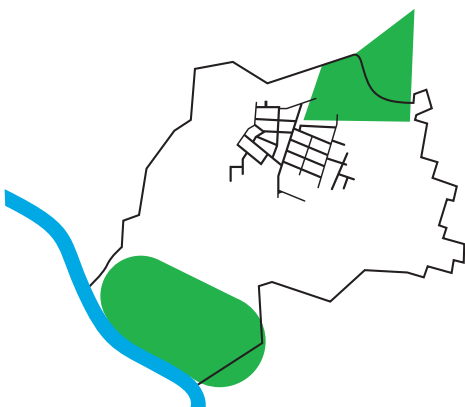
