## Contribute to the future of water management in your area

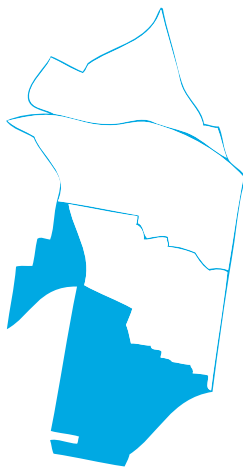
