How will the survey results be used?

The results will be used by the OurRiver team to decide what type of community education project/s will be implemented in your local area. The decision will be made using the following criteria:

- 1. The project must contribute to the community water vision and goals developed by members of the Munni Street Subcatchment community (the Subcatchment is a defined area that includes parts of Alexandria, Darlington, Erskineville, Eveleigh and Newtown).
- 2. The project must meet local community requirements as determined by the survey.
- 3. The project must be able to be implemented by September 2010.

What is OurRiver?

The OurRiver project is working with local communities and councils to improve the health of the Cooks River, and to promote more sustainable water management in urban areas. The project is a partnership between eight councils, the Cooks River Foreshore Working Group and Monash University, and is funded by the NSW Environmental Trust.
